

Statement of Purpose:

The National Parks Second Century Action Coalition is a national coalition dedicated to promoting the protection, restoration, and operation of the National Park System to benefit the health and well-being of current and future generations. The coalition will take actions that help the National Park Service achieve conservation goals, foster visitor enjoyment, engage youth, promote tourism, preserve cultural heritage, support educational and recreation opportunities, and foster diversity through federal, fee, and philanthropic funding and other measures.

The coalition will take a series of complementary actions that:

- 1. advance sustainable funding options that supplement, but do not supplant, federal appropriations;
- 2. address the deferred maintenance backlog and operational needs of the parks system and other revenue sources;
- 3. promote public-private partnerships;
- 4. increase philanthropic giving inspired by federal fiscal responsibility for our national parks;
- 5. encourage collaborations with gateway communities that benefit the parks while promoting the tourism economy;
- 6. foster efforts to increase attendance among under-utilized parks; and
- enhance visitor experiences for all ages and diverse backgrounds through culturally relevant, diverse approaches that enhance health, understanding, and civic engagement opportunities.
