

# GOOD WORKS AHEAD

The 2020 passage of the Great American Outdoors Act established the National Parks and Public Lands Legacy Restoration Fund, setting aside up to **\$6.65 BILLION** to address critical repair needs in national parks. Here's a snapshot of the number of plans in the pipeline, the parks and states benefiting, and the funds allocated for specific projects during the first two years of the five-year investment.
